Tour de Cure Presention:

Alexis Pollak and Audra Fleming from ADA Tour de Cure event spoke to us about MTCCSD participation in 2010 Tour de Cure scheduled for April 17, 2010.



We can participate in two important ways: 1) MTCCSD Ride Team, 2) MTCCSD sponsoring of training rides.

Audra is allowing individual riders to join the MTCCSD team at no cost, saving \$15 per member if we register through our team captain, Carlos. She will also allow us to "share" contributions. If someone exceeds the \$150/rider min contribution, they can transfer the excess to another MTCCSD team member.

We will also combine our regular Sat and Sun training rides with ADA training rides. ADA will promote MTCCSD as a Tour de Cure training partner. Participation in training rides will ramp-up in early 2010 as the event approaches. We need to make sure that ADA riders sign liability waivers and wear helmets, etc. Julio and Carlos will take responsibility for making sure our rides meet ADA requirements.

Audra also told us that we can have a table and banner to promote our club at the Tour de Cure event at no cost (normally a \$500-\$700 charge.)

City College Europe Bike Trip:

Ellen Turkel from City College spoke to us about a bike tour of Switzerland and Italy she is setting-up for Summer 2011. Different levels of ride participation are possible and total tour length will be approx. 17 days. Cost, incl. airfaire, will be approx. \$6K.
